The second VMO participates on weekend call and the third has a standing commitment to cover Monday nights only. There fore the roster works out top be one weekend in three (provided no one is on leave) and week every second day during the week Tuesday to Thursdays.

It is your responsibility to ensure that the visa applicant is aware of the conditions of their visa as outlined in this letter. Please ensure they receive a copy of this letter (a faxed copy is acceptable).

What the person you have sponsored must do

If they have not already done so, the person you wish to sponsor needs to lodge a visa application with the Immigration Office nearest them, together with a copy of this letter.


