After I asked Dr Qureshi to leave the cubicle, I asked Pt.A why she was upset. Pt.A stated that the (same) doctor was present previously while she was having a seizure. Pt.A stated she could feel him kissing the (left) side of her face and also said that she could feel him putting his hand down the front of her shirt. She stated that even though she can feel and hear things during a seizure, she is unable to respond. This incident was reported to Clinical Nurse C. Morrison and Nurse Manager J. Marese.

I attended to PtA after RN Tarlington asked me to be with PtA while she reported the incident. While at PtA's bedside, I asked PtA if she was alright. PtA proceeded to tell me the same story (as above). She also stated that the doctor, before the seizure, began stroking her hair - PtA indicated the left side. PtA stated that she thought nothing of this gesture.
