- (i) Dr be approved special purpose registration under Section 135 and Section 143A to fill an area of need within the specialty of Otolaryngology Head and Neck Surgery at Cairns Health Service District from 8 December 2004 to 31 August 2005;
- (ii) conditions be imposed to enable Dr 1 to competently and safely undertake the approved activity pursuant to Section 141 of the Act as follows:-
 - 1. Dr must undertake 12 months of "assessment under oversight" in the specialty of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery;
 - Dr must practise with oversight provided by two Fellows nominated by the RACS Board of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery for the term of the assessment period;
 - 3.
